A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMPLOYER-UNION HEALTH BENEFITS TRUST FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 87A-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended as follows:
- 3 1. By adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
- 4 and to read:
- 5 ""Credited service" means service as an officer or employee
- 6 paid by the State or county, service during the period of leave
- 7 of absence or exchange if the individual is paid by the State or
- 8 county during the leave of absence or exchange, and service
- 9 during the period of unpaid leave of absence or exchange if the
- 10 individual is engaged in the performance of a governmental
- 11 function or if the unpaid leave of absence is an approved leave
- of absence for professional improvement."
- By amending the definitions of "employee" and "part-
- 14 time, temporary, and seasonal or casual employee" to read:
- 15 ""Employee" means an employee or officer of the State,
- 16 county, or legislature,
- 17 (1) Including:
- 18 (A) An elective officer;

2	(C)]	(B) An officer or employee under an authorized
3		leave of absence;
4	[(D) -]	(C) An employee of the Hawaii national guard
5		although paid from federal funds;
6	[(E)]	(D) A retired member of the employees'
7		retirement system; the county pension system; or
8		the police, firefighters, or bandsmen pension
9		system of the State or county;
10	[(F)]	(E) A salaried and full-time member of a board,
11		commission, or agency appointed by the governor
12		or the mayor of a county; and
13	[-(G)-]	(F) A person employed by contract for a period
14		not exceeding one year, where the director of
15 .		human resources development, personnel services,
16		or civil service has certified that the service
17		is essential or needed in the public interest and
18		that, because of circumstances surrounding its
19		fulfillment, personnel to perform the service
20		cannot be obtained through normal civil service
21		recruitment procedures,

But excluding:

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1	(A)	A designated beneficiary of a retired member of
2		the employees' retirement system; the county
3		pension system; or the police, firefighters, or
4		bandsmen pension system of the State or county;
5	(B)	Except as allowed under paragraph [+1++G)
6		(1)(F), a person employed temporarily on a fee or
7		contract basis; and
8	(C)	A part-time, temporary, and seasonal or casual
9		employee.
10	"Part-tim	e, temporary, and seasonal or casual employee"
11	means a person	employed for fewer than three months [and] or
12	whose employmen	nt is less than one-half of a full-time equivalent
13	position."	
14	SECTION 2	. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
15	and stricken.	New statutory material is underscored.
16	SECTION 3	. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
