A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII STATE PUBLIC LIBRARY SYSTEM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Act 51, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, was to in			
2	part transfer the control of certain functions of executive			
3	branch agencies that pertained to education personnel and			
4	facilities to the department of education to increase			
5	operational efficiency of the department while reducing			
6	bureaucracy. However, after enactment of Act 51, the department			
7	of human resources development continued to provide services to			
8	all employees of the Hawaii state public library system and the			
9	Hawaii state public library system employees were not a part of			
10	or included in the department of education personnel system.			
11	This Act clarifies the intent of Act 51 by amending section			
12	46 of Act 51, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, to confirm that all			
13	personnel in the Hawaii state public library system are within			
14	the personnel system administered by the department of human			
15	resources development, and are not part of the personnel system			
16	administered by the department of education. This Act reaffirms			
17	the human resources functions currently performed by the

- 1 public library system. These human resources functions include,
- 2 but are not limited to: payroll, records, transactions, leave,
- 3 reports, recruitment, certification, examination, management,
- 4 classification, and labor relations. Although the department of
- 5 education and the Hawaii state public library system are
- 6 controlled and overseen by the board of education, Act 51 was
- 7 silent regarding all employees of the Hawaii state public
- 8 library system. The human resources functions of the Hawaii
- 9 state public library system are best served by the personnel
- 10 system administered by the department of human resources
- 11 development, rather than the department of education. In
- 12 addition, the department of accounting and general services
- 13 continues to be the expending agency for the Hawaii public
- 14 library system's capital improvement funds and continues to
- 15 perform repair and maintenance for the Hawaii public library
- 16 system.
- 17 SECTION 2. Act 51, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, is amended
- 18 by amending section 46 to read as follows:
- 19 "SECTION 46. (a) All the rights, powers, functions,
- 20 duties, and resources of:

2		relating to capital improvement programs, including
3		the:
4		(A) Expending of capital improvement funds for the
5		acquisition and development of land, the design
6		and construction of new facilities, and the
7		making of renovations or additions to existing
8		facilities, including moneys in the state

11		(B) Buying, purchasing, renting, leasing, or
12		otherwise acquiring of any good, service, or
13		construction, including the description of
14		requirements, selection and solicitation of
15		sources, preparation and awarding of contracts,
16		payment of vendors, and all other phases of
17		contract administration;
18	(2)	The department of accounting and general services
19		relating to repair and maintenance functions not
20		transferred to the department of education under
21	•	section 44 of this Act; and

1	(3) The	department of human resources development relating
2	to	the:
3	(A)	Operation of a centralized human resources system
4		that encompasses the classes of work performed by
5		department of education employees, and that
6		integrates payroll, records, transactions,
7		leaves, and reports; and
8	(B)	Recruitment, certification, examination,
9		management, classification, and compensation of
10		department of education employees, including
11	· .	labor relations;
12	are transferr	ed to the department of education effective July 1,
13	2005, subject	to repeal by subsequent legislation.
14	(b) All	moneys budgeted in support of each position to be
15	transferred t	o the department of education, including moneys for
16	direct and in	direct employee benefits, are transferred to the
17	department of	education effective July 1, 2005, subject to
18	repeal by sub	sequent legislation.
19	(c) Thi	s section shall not apply to the Hawaii state
20	public librar	y system and its employees."
21	SECTION	3. New statutory material is underscored.
22	SECTION	4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
