A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTRIC VEHICLE PARKING.

	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:
1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to clarify
2	requirements pertaining to parking spaces for electric vehicles.
3	SECTION 2. Section 291-71, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
4	amended to read as follows:
5	[[+]§291-71[+] Designation of parking spaces for electric
6	vehicles; charging [units.] system. [All public, private, and
7	government parking facilities that are available for use by the
8	general public and have] (a) Places of public accommodation
9	with at least one hundred parking spaces available for use by
10	the general public shall [designate] have at least one [per cent
11	of] parking [spaces] space exclusively for electric vehicles [by
12	December 31, 2011, provided that at least one of the parking
13	spaces designated for electric vehicles is located near the
14	building entrance and is and equipped with an electric vehicle
15	charging [unit.] system located anywhere in the parking

16 structure or lot by July 1, 2012; provided that no parking space

designated for electric vehicles shall displace or reduce 17

accessible stalls required by the Americans with Disabilities 18



- Act Accessibility Guidelines. Spaces shall be designated, 2 clearly marked, and the exclusive designation enforced. 3 electric vehicle charging units shall meet recognized standards, including SAE J1772 of the Society of Automotive Engineers.] 4 Owners of multiple parking [lots] facilities within the State 5 6 may designate and electrify fewer parking spaces than required 7 in one or more of their owned properties [as long as]; provided that the scheduled requirement is met for the total number of 8 aggregate spaces on all of their owned properties. 9 **10** [When the number of registered electric vehicles in the 11 State reaches five thousand, the spaces designated for electric vehicles shall increase to two per cent of parking spaces. The 12 13 number of spaces designated for electric vehicles shall continue to increase by one per cent for each additional five thousand 14 electric vehicles registered in the State until the percentage 15 reaches ten per cent of parking spaces.] 16 17 (b) For the purposes of this section[- "electric vehicle" means an electric vehicle or neighborhood electric vehicle with 18 19 an electric vehicle license plate.]: 20 "Electric vehicle" means: A neighborhood electric vehicle as defined in section 21 (1)22 286-2; or

18	parks a n	on-electric vehicle in a space designated and marked as	
19	reserved	for electric vehicles shall receive a warning."	
20	SECT	ION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed	
21	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.		
22	SECT	ION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
