A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the f	ull

- 2 implementation of the department of agriculture's electronic
- 3 importer manifest program is important. The electronic importer
- 4 manifest program provides for the transfer from an importer to
- 5 the plant quarantine inspector of data on all commodities of
- 6 interest imported by aircraft or ship arrival. This electronic
- 7 manifest system is a requirement for the department of
- 8 agriculture's transitional facilities program, as the data is
- 9 used by the inspector to determine the port and inspection
- 10 status of each commodity, thus allowing for the movement of the
- 11 selected commodities through the port.
- 12 The State's integrated technology consultant found
- 13 excessive backlogs in agriculture inspections due to the State's
- 14 lack of implementation of integrated technologies, as reported
- 15 in the Honolulu Star Advertiser on September 30, 2011. The
- 16 electronic importer manifest system electronically links the
- 17 importer's commodities manifest to the plant quarantine branch's
- 18 invicta database system.

8		and airport cargo congestion;	
9	(4)	Promote compliance with the State's biosecurity law,	
10		by allowing performance of produce inspections in food

14	(6)	Enable the provision of data to measure food self-	
15		sufficiency and sustainability.	
16	The	purpose of this Act is to authorize the department of	
17	agricultu	re to expend funds to fully implement the electronic	
18	importer	manifest program in the State and enable the department	
19	of agriculture to reimburse private companies that developed the		
20	program in 2011 and 2012.		
21	SECT	ION 2. Section 150A-4.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
22	amended by	y amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

- 1 "(b) The moneys in the pest inspection, quarantine, and
- 2 eradication fund shall be expended by the department for the
- 3 operation of biosecurity and pest inspection, quarantine,
- 4 eradication, and monitoring programs[-]; the electronic importer
- 5 manifest program; related facilities[7]; the execution of
- 6 emergency remedial measures when pests are detected in the
- 7 course of inspection and quarantine activities by the
- 8 department[7]; training of inspectors[7]; education of the
- 9 agricultural industry, permit and certificate holders, and the
- 10 general public as to import requirements $[\tau]$; and for any other
- 11 purposes deemed necessary to carry out the purposes of this
- 12 chapter. In addition, the moneys shall be expended to
- 13 facilitate the processing and issuance of permits and
- 14 microorganism import documents and for the operations,
- 15 activities, and monitoring of permitted and certified plants,
- 16 animals, and microorganisms."
- 17 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the pest
- 18 inspection, quarantine, and eradication fund the sum of \$200,000
- 19 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013
- 20 to implement the electronic importer manifest program.
- 21 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 22 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.

- 1 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
