A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PENAL CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 706-623, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows: 2 3 When the court has sentenced a defendant to be placed on probation, the period of probation shall be as follows, 4 unless the court enters the reason therefor on the record and 5 sentences the defendant to a shorter period of probation: 6 7 (a) Ten years upon conviction of a class A felony; Five years upon conviction of a class B or class C (b) 8 felony; One year upon conviction of a misdemeanor; except that 10 (C) upon a conviction under section 586-4, 586-11, or 709-11 906, the court may sentence the defendant to a period 12 of probation not exceeding two years; or 13 Six months upon conviction of a petty misdemeanor; (d) 14 provided that up to one year may be imposed upon a 15 finding of good cause. 16 The court, on application of a probation officer, on application 17

- 1 defendant at any time. Prior to the court granting early
- 2 discharge, the defendant's probation officer shall be required
- 3 to report to the court concerning the defendant's compliance or
- 4 non-compliance with the conditions of probation and the court
- 5 shall afford the prosecuting attorney an opportunity to be
- 6 heard. The terms of probation provided in this part, other than
- 7 in this section, shall not apply to sentences of probation
- 8 imposed under section 706-606.3."
- 9 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
