## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENDANGERED AND THREATENED SPECIES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 195D-27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

2	repealed.
3	["\$195D-27 Administrative enforcement of rules, plans,
4	agreements, or licenses. (a) Any person may petition the
5	chairperson to appoint a hearings officer to hear a request to
6	enjoin any person, including the State and any other government
7	agency, alleged to be in violation of this chapter, including
8	any rule adopted pursuant to this chapter, habitat conservation
9	plan, safe harbor agreement, or incidental take license, or to
10	require the State to take action to enforce this chapter,
11	including any rule adopted pursuant to this chapter or any term
12	of a habitat conservation plan, safe harbor agreement, or
13	incidental take license.
14	(b) Upon receipt of a petition, the chairperson shall make
15	a diligent effort to resolve the subject matter of the petition
16	and, if appropriate, to cause the noncomplying or other
17	responsible party to comply with the habitat conservation plan,
18	safe harbor agreement, or incidental take license. If the

1	CHAIRPERSON IS UNABLE to resolve the subject matter or the
2	petition within a period of time deemed reasonable under the
3	circumstances, but in no event more than ninety days; or if the
4	petitioner is not satisfied with the chairperson's resolution of
5	the subject matter, then the chairperson shall appoint a
6	hearings officer to hear the petition. The hearings officer
7	shall commence a contested case hearing in accordance with
8	chapter 91 and, within thirty days of the completion of the
9	hearing, grant in whole or in part, or deny the petition.
10	(c) Nothing in this section shall grant any authority
11	whatsoever upon a hearings officer to assess monetary damages or
12	criminal penalties against any party found to be in violation of
13	this chapter, however, the hearings officer shall issue findings
14	of fact and, if appropriate, an order directing the party found
15	to be in violation to take specific action to comply with this
16	<del>chapter.</del>
17	(d) Any person who believes that a violation of a habitat
18	conservation plan, safe harbor agreement, or incidental take
19	license has occurred, is occurring, or is likely to occur, may
20	petition the chairperson for an immediate hearing. The petition
21	shall be accompanied by an affidavit alleging:

1	<del>(1)</del>	Specific facts showing that the continued existence of
2		an endangered or threatened species is likely to be
3		jeopardized unless the alleged violation is
4		immediately enjoined; and
. 5	<del>(2)</del>	The efforts that have been made to notify the
6		landowner of the alleged violation.
7	If the ch	airperson finds that there exists good cause for a
8	hearing,	then a hearings officer shall be appointed who shall
9	<del>conduct a</del>	hearing forthwith, and in any event within forty eight
10	hours aft	er the filing of the petition. If the hearings officer
11	determine	s that there is a substantial likelihood that the
12	continued	existence of an endangered or threatened species will
13	<del>be jeopar</del>	dized unless the violation is immediately enjoined,
14	then the	hearings officer shall order temporary injunctive
15	<del>relief, w</del>	hi <del>ch shall expire upon such terms as the hearings</del>
16	<del>officer d</del>	etermines."]
17	SECT	ION 2. Act 380, Session Laws of Hawaii 1997, as
18	amended by	y Act 3, Session Laws of Hawaii 2001, as amended by Act
19	90, Sessi	on Laws of Hawaii 2006, is amended by amending section
20	13 to rea	d as follows:
21	"SEC	TION 13. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
22	provided	that no new safe harbor agreements, habitat
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- 1 conservation plans, or incidental take licenses issued pursuant
- 2 to section 195D-4, 195D-21, or 195D-22, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 3 shall be approved or issued [subsequent to] on or after [July 1,
- 4 <del>2012.</del>] June 30, 2017."
- 5 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
