A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the development of
- 2 additional public housing is essential to the well-being of
- 3 Hawaii's poorest residents. The ability of the State to provide
- 4 an adequate supply of safe, affordable public housing can be
- 5 enhanced by public-private partnerships that authorize private
- 6 entities to undertake all or a portion of the study, planning,
- 7 design, development, financing, acquisition, installation,
- 8 construction, improvement, operation, or maintenance of public
- 9 housing facilities. Public-private partnership public housing
- 10 projects provide a sound economic investment opportunity for the
- 11 private sector and the State with increased options to develop
- 12 this critically needed housing.
- 13 The purpose of this Act is to encourage joint ventures with
- 14 private parties for the development of public housing.
- 15 SECTION 2. Chapter 356D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 17 and to read as follows:

1	"§356D- Development of property; partnership or
2	development agreement. (a) Any public housing project may be
3	developed under sections 356D-11 and 356D-12 by the authority in
4	partnership or under a development agreement with a private
5	party; provided that a written partnership or development
6	agreement is executed by the authority. At a minimum, the
7	partnership or development agreement shall provide for:
8	(1) A determination by the authority that the partnership
9	or development agreement is for a public purpose; and
10	(2) Final approval by the authority of the plans and
11	specifications for the public housing project.
12	(b) For the development of public housing projects
13	pursuant to subsection (a), except as provided by federal law or
L4	regulation, the authority shall not be subject to chapters 103
15	and 103D or any and all other requirements of law for
L6	competitive bidding for partnership or development agreements,
L 7	construction contracts, or other contracts; provided that the
18	authority shall develop internal policies and procedures for the
19	procurement of goods, services, and construction, consistent
20	with the goals of public accountability and public procurement
21	practices.
