A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CYBERBULLYING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 708-893, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:		
3	"(1) A p	erson commits the offense of use of a computer in	
4	the commission of a separate crime if the person:		
5	(a) Inte	ntionally uses a computer to obtain control over	
6	the	property of the victim to commit theft in the	
7	firs	t or second degree; or	
8	(b) Know	ingly uses a computer to identify, select,	
9	soli	cit, persuade, coerce, entice, induce, [ex]	
10	proc	ure, pursue, surveil, contact, harass, annoy, or	
11	alarm the victim or intended victim of the following		
12	offe	nses:	
13	(i)	Section 707-726, relating to custodial	
14		interference in the first degree;	
15	(ii)	Section 707-727, relating to custodial	
16		interference in the second degree;	
17	(iii)	Section 707-731, relating to sexual assault in	
18		the second degree;	

1	(iv)	Section 707-732, relating to sexual assault in	
2		the third degree;	
3	(v)	Section 707-733, relating to sexual assault in	
4		the fourth degree;	
5	(vi)	Section 707-751, relating to promoting child	
6		abuse in the second degree; [or]	
7	(vii)	Section 711-1106, relating to harassment;	
8	(viii)	Section 711-1106.5, relating to harassment by	
9		stalking; or	
10	[(vii)]	(ix) Section 712-1215, relating to promoting	
11		pornography for minors."	
12	SECTION 2. The provisions of this Act shall be liberally		
13	construed to give effect to the purposes thereof.		
14	SECTION 3	. Nothing in this Act is intended to interfere	
15	with the First Amendment rights of free speech and expression o		
16	any person affected.		
17	SECTION 4	. This Act does not affect rights and duties that	
18	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were		
19	begun before its effective date.		
20	SECTION 5	. If any provision of this Act, or the	
21	application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held		
22	invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or

- 4 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed

- 6 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
