A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE WEST MAUI OCEAN RECREATION MANAGEMENT AREA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that increased
- 2 recreational and commercial activities in Hawaii's nearshore
- 3 waters have led to safety concerns, and in some cases, tragic
- 4 results. The legislature also finds that given the popularity
- 5 of ocean activities in Kaanapali on the island of Maui, the
- 6 department of land and natural resources should establish a west
- 7 Maui ocean recreation management area advisory committee
- 8 comprised of users of the ocean to work with the department on
- 9 issues arising relating to the area, particularly the waters of
- 10 Kaanapali.
- 11 SECTION 2. (a) Not later than September 1, 2012, the
- 12 department of land and natural resources shall establish a
- 13 temporary west Maui ocean recreation management area advisory
- 14 committee that shall advise the department of land and natural
- 15 resources on issues related to the uses and maintenance of state
- 16 waters within the west Maui ocean recreation management area,
- 17 particularly within the waters adjacent to Kaanapali on the
- 18 island of Maui.

- 1 (b) The temporary advisory committee shall consist of five
- 2 members of the west Maui community appointed by the chairperson
- 3 of the board of land and natural resources without regard to
- 4 section 26-34, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as follows:
- 5 (1) One swimming enthusiast;
- 6 (2) One paddling enthusiast;
- 7 (3) One surfing enthusiast;
- 8 (4) One commercial boating enthusiast; and
- 9 (5) One fishing enthusiast.
- 10 No member shall be made subject to chapter 84, Hawaii Revised
- 11 Statutes, solely because of that member's participation as a
- 12 member of the temporary advisory committee. The temporary
- 13 advisory committee created by this section shall be terminated
- 14 on June 30, 2015.
- 15 SECTION 3. The department of land and natural resources
- 16 shall submit an annual report to the legislature, no later than
- 17 twenty days prior to the convening of each regular session
- 18 beginning with the 2013 legislative session and until the
- 19 expiration of the temporary west Maui ocean recreation
- 20 management area advisory committee, regarding the findings and

- 1 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, of the
- 2 temporary west Maui ocean recreation management area advisory
- 3 committee.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
