A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CIGARETTES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that reduced ignition
- 2 propensity cigarettes are expected to reduce accidental fires
- 3 and related personal injury and property damage caused by
- 4 cigarette smoking.
- 5 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for the
- 6 implementation of the reduced ignition propensity cigarette
- 7 certification pursuant to section 132C-4, Hawaii Revised
- 8 Statutes.
- 9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the temporary
- 10 deposits account in the trust fund of the department of labor
- 11 and industrial relations the sum of \$400,000 or so much thereof
- as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to be deposited to
- 13 the credit of the reduced ignition propensity cigarette program
- 14 special fund established pursuant to section 132C-9, Hawaii
- 15 Revised Statutes.
- 16 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the reduced
- 17 ignition propensity cigarette program special fund the sum of
- 18 \$400,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year

- 1 2012-2013 for the purpose of funding one full-time
- 2 administrator, one full-time assistant, and other costs of
- 3 fulfilling the requirements of section 132C-4, Hawaii Revised
- 4 Statutes.
- 5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 6 labor and industrial relations.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
