A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SMALL BUSINESS REGULATORY REVIEW BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. The purpose of this Act is to ensure the
2	stability	of the small business regulatory review board by:
3	(1)	Authorizing the board with good cause to request a
4		written response from the agency explaining the
5		rationale used to deny the public concerns;
6	(2)	Reducing the size of the board from eleven to nine
7		members, with eight members appointed at large and the
8		director of business, economic development, and
9		tourism, or the director's designated representative,
10		to serve as an ex officio voting member of the board;
11		and
12	(3)	Requiring each agency to notify the board on an annual
13		basis of any rules that should be amended or repealed
14		to reflect statutory amendments or repeals.
15	SECT	ION 2. Section 201M-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
16	amended to	read as follows:
17	"[+]!	\$201M-3[] Small business statement after public

2	business	statement to the small business regulatory review board
3	and the d	epartmental advisory committee on small business after
4	the publi	c hearing is held. This section shall not apply to
5	emergency	rules. The small business statement required by this
6	section s	hall provide the following information:
7	(1)	A description of how opinions or comments from
8		affected small business were solicited, a summary of
9		the public and small business comments, and a summary
10		of the agency's response to those comments;
11	(2)	The number of persons who:
12		(A) Attended the public hearing;
13		(B) Testified at the hearing; and
14		(C) Submitted written comments; and
15	(3)	If there was a request to change the proposed rule at
16		the hearing in a way that affected small business, a
17		statement of the reasons for adopting the proposed
18		rule [without the], the reason why a requested change
19		was not made, and the problems or negative result the
20		change would provide if adopted.
21	(b)	If the small business regulatory review board finds

that a statement provided pursuant to subsection (a)(3):

22

1	(1) Indicates inconsistency with any of the agency's
2	determinations under section 201M-2(b); or
3	(2) Does not address the concerns of public input,
4	the board with good cause may request a written response from
5	the agency explaining the rationale used to deny the public
6	concerns within ten working days of receipt of the small
7	business statement after public hearing. The agency shall
8	respond in writing to the board's concerns within ten working
9	days.
10	(c) The written response from an agency required in
11	subsection (b), at a minimum, shall:
12	(1) Specifically address each issue and concern raised in
13	the board's request for a written response; and
14	(2) Affirmatively state that the agency has considered all
15	written and oral testimony received at the agency's
16	public hearing and has addressed all issues or
17	concerns raised in the written and oral testimony."
18	SECTION 3. Section 201M-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
19	amended by amending subsections (b) and (c) to read as follows:
20	(b) The board shall consist of [eleven] nine members, who
21	shall be appointed by the governor pursuant to section 26-34[-

1	Nominations to fill vacancies shall be made from names submitted		
2	by the review board.]; provided that:		
3	(1)	Three members shall be appointed from a list of	
4		nominees submitted by the president of the senate;	
5	(2)	Three members shall be appointed from a list of	
6		nominees submitted by the speaker of the house of	
7		representatives;	
8	(3)	Two members shall be appointed by the governor;	
9	(4)	The director of business, economic development, and	
10		tourism, or the director's designated representative,	
11		shall serve as an ex officio voting member of the	
12		board;	
13	(5)	The appointments shall reflect representation of a	
14		variety of businesses in the State; [provided that no]	
15	(6)	$\underline{\mathtt{No}}$ more than two members shall be representatives from	
16		the same type of business[7]; and [that there]	
17	(7)	There shall be at least [two-representatives] one	
18		representative from each county.	
19	For the p	urposes of paragraphs (1) and (2), nominations shall be	
20	solicited	from small business organizations, state and county	
21	chambers of commerce, and other interested business

(c) [All] Except for the ex officio member, all members of 1 the board shall be either a current or former owner or officer 2 of a business and shall not be an officer or employee of the 3 federal, state, or county government. A majority of the board 4 shall elect the chairperson. The chairperson shall serve a term 5 of not more than one year, unless removed earlier by a two-6 thirds vote of all members to which the board is entitled." 7 SECTION 4. Section 201M-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 8 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 9 "(a) Each agency having rules that affect small business 10 shall submit by June 30 of each odd-numbered year, a list of 11 12 those rules to the small business regulatory review board[-]; 13 provided that, by June 30 of each year, each agency shall submit to the small business regulatory review board a list of any 14 rules to be amended or repealed, based upon any new, amended, or 15 repealed statute. The agency shall also submit a report 16 describing the specific public purpose or interest for adopting **17** the respective rules that affect small business and any other 18 reasons to justify [its] their continued implementation." 19 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 20 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 21 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012. 22
