A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LIABILITY INSURANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§321- Liability insurance. (a) All operators of
5	adult foster homes under section 321-11.2 and adult residential
6	care homes, assisted living facilities, and expanded adult
7	residential care homes as defined in section 321-15.1 shall
8	obtain and maintain liability insurance with respect to their
9	operation of the homes or facilities in a coverage amount deemed
10	sufficient by the department.
11	This section shall not apply to operators of adult foster
12	homes, adult residential care homes, assisted living facilities,
13	and expanded adult residential care homes that:
14	(1) Are operating under a contract with the department of
15	human services or the department of health; and
16	(2) Are in compliance with the liability insurance
17	coverage requirements of that contract.

- 1 (b) The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter
- 2 91 to effectuate the purposes of this section."
- 3 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
