## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DISABILITY AND COMMUNICATION ACCESS BOARD SPECIAL FUND.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 348F-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+]\$348F-7[+] Disability and communication access board
- 4 special fund. (a) There is established the disability and
- 5 communication access board special fund to be administered by
- 6 the disability and communication access board. All moneys
- 7 received by the disability and communication access board [as
- 8 application fees for credentialing of interpreters] shall be
- 9 deposited into the special fund. All interest earned or accrued
- 10 on moneys deposited into this special fund shall become part of
- 11 the special fund.
- 12 (b) Moneys in the disability and communication access
- 13 board special fund shall be expended to [cover all] defray costs
- 14 of administering this chapter [including the costs of
- 15 administering the program for the state credentialing of
- 16 interpreters].

1	(c)	All	moneys	collected	as	application	fees	or	fees	for

- 2 continuing education units for credentialing of interpreters
- 3 shall be deposited into the disability and communication access
- 4 board special fund."
- 5 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
