BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

6	"Street" shall have the same meaning as in section 291C-1.					
7	"Vulnerable user" means:					
8	(1)	A pedestrian legally within a street or public				
9		highway;				
10	(2)	A roadway worker actually engaged in work upon a				
11		street or public highway or in work upon utility				
12		facilities along a street or public highway, or				
13		engaged in the provision of emergency services within				
14		a street or public highway, including but not limited				
15		to:				
16		(A) Construction and maintenance workers; and				
17		(B) Police, fire, and other emergency responders; or				

1	<u>(3)</u>	A pe	rson legally operating any of the following within		
2		the	street or public highway:		
3		(A)	A bicycle;		
4		<u>(B)</u>	A moped;		
5		<u>(C)</u>	An electric personal assistive mobility device;

7		<u>(D)</u>	A wheelchair conveyance or other personal		
8			mobility device."		
9	SECTION 2. Section 707-702.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is				
10	amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:				
11	"(1) A person [is guilty of] commits the offense of				
12	negligent homicide in the first degree if that person causes the				
13	death of [another]:				
14	<u>(a)</u>	Anot	her person by the operation of a vehicle in a

4	<u>(a)</u>	Another person by the operation of a vehicle in a			
5		negligent manner[-]; or			
6	<u>(b)</u>	A vulnerable user by the operation of a vehicle in a			
7		manner that constitutes simple negligence as defined			
8		in section 707-704(2)."			
9	SECTI	ION 4. Section 707-705, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is			
10	amended by	amending subsection (1) to read as follows:			
11	"(1)	A person [is guilty of] commits the offense of			
12	negligent	injury in the first degree if that person causes			
13	[serious]:				
14	<u>(a)</u>	Serious bodily injury to another person by the			
15		operation of a motor vehicle in a negligent manner[+];			
16		<u>or</u>			
17	<u>(b)</u>	Substantial bodily injury to a vulnerable user by the			
18		operation of a motor vehicle in a negligent manner."			
19	SECTI	ON 5. This Act does not affect rights and duties that			
20	matured, p	enalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were			
21	begun before its effective date.
