The Hawaii Government Employees Association and the State Executive Branch are expected to reach an understanding very shortly relating to "favored nations" provisions in agreements concerning Bargaining Units 2, 3, 4, and 13 ratified in March of 2011.

The following summaries of the included and excluded additional funding requirements, compared to the Executive Supplemental Budget based on those agreements for the current fiscal biennium, are being transmitted to the Legislature for information purposes at this time due to the lateness in the legislative timetable. It is anticipated that the signed supplemental agreement will be available by close of business on Friday, April 27, 2012.
