## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE MOTOR VEHICLE RENTAL INDUSTRY.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 437D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: 4 "§437D- Additional driver fee prohibited; exception. 5 (a) No lessor or officer, employee, agent, or other 6 representative of the lessor shall assess a daily additional driver fee against a lessor, except as otherwise provided in 7 8 this section. (b) A lessor or officer, employee, agent, or other 9 10 representative of the lessor may assess, against any lessee who 11 is twenty-five years of age or older, a one-time, additional 12 driver fee of not more than \$10 for each additional driver. The 13 one-time fee shall be valid for the duration of the contract. (c) The restriction on the assessment and collection of an 14 additional driver fee established in this section shall not 15
- apply to any additional driver who is under twenty-five years
  old."
- SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
