RELATING TO LABOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 387-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "\$387-2 Minimum wages. Except as provided in section 4 387-9 and this section, every employer shall pay to each employee employed by the employer, wages at the rate of not less 5 than: \$6.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2003; 7 (1)8 (2) \$6.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2006; [and] 9 (3) \$7.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2007[-]; 10 \$8.14 per hour beginning January 1, 2013; and (4)Beginning July 1, 2013 and adjusted annually on each 11 (5) 12 succeeding July 1, an hourly wage computed by dividing 13 the federal poverty level for a family of two persons 14 for Hawaii by 2,080. 15 The hourly wage of a tipped employee may be deemed to be 16 increased on account of tips if the employee is paid not less **17** than 25 cents below the applicable minimum wage by the 18 employee's employer and the combined amount the employee HB LRB 12-0458.doc

- 1 receives from the employee's employer and in tips is at least 50
- 2 cents more than the applicable minimum wage."
