BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

4	"(a)	Each	tire retailer shall:		
5	(1)	Accep	t, at the point of transfer, in a quantity at		
6		least	equal to the number of new motor vehicle tires		
7		purch	ased by a customer, <u>used</u> motor vehicle tires		
8		offer	ed by the customer[-];		
9	(2)	<u>If a</u>	used motor vehicle tire is not exchanged at the		
10		time	of sale, collect a \$25 deposit on the new tire;		
11		provided that:			
12		<u>(A)</u>	The deposit shall be returned to the customer		
13			when the customer delivers a used motor vehicle		
14	•		tire within thirty days of the date of sale;		
15		<u>(B)</u>	All funds received by a seller as a deposit on a		
16		:	motor vehicle tire shall be held in trust and		
17			separately accounted for by the seller. Any		
18			interest on those funds shall inure to the		

1			benefit of the seller. Annually on July 1, all
2			deposits not returned to customers in exchange
3			for used motor vehicle tires during the previous
4			year ending June 30, shall inure to the benefit
5			of the seller; and
6		<u>(C)</u>	This paragraph shall not apply to motorcycle or
7			bicycle tires; and
8	[(2)]	<u>(3)</u>	Post written notice which shall be at least
9		[fiv	e] eight inches by [seven] eleven and one-half
10		inch	es in size and easily visible to customers and
11		shal	l contain the universal recycling symbol and the
12		foll	owing language:
13		(A)	"It is illegal to discard a motor vehicle tire";
14		(B)	"Recycle your used tires";
15		(C)	"State law requires us to accept used motor
16			vehicle tires for recycling or disposal, in
17			exchange for new tires purchased"; [and]
18		(D)	"The final price of a new tire includes disposal
19			of your old tire. The disposal fee is not
20			subject to reduction or refund[-]"; and

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1	(E) "A deposit of \$25 will be charged for each new						
2	motor vehicle tire that is not exchanged with a						
3	used motor vehicle tire"."						
4	2. By amending subsections (c) and (d) to read:						
5	"(c) Any advertising pertaining to the price of motor						
6	vehicle tires shall disclose whether a separate disposal fee may						
7	be added to the final price of the tire $[\frac{and}{L}]_{\underline{L}}$ the actual cost						
8	of the disposal fee[\div], and the actual cost of the deposit for						
9	each new motor vehicle tire that is not exchanged with a used						
10	motor vehicle tire.						
11	(d) For businesses utilizing advertising prepared out of						
12	the State a sign no smaller than three square feet, placed at						
13	the point of sale stating: "The price of tires includes						
14	disposal of your old tires" and "A deposit of \$25 will be						
15	charged for each new motor vehicle tire that is not exchanged						
16	with a used motor vehicle tire" may be substituted."						
17	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed						
18	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.						
19	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
