A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO UNDERSERVED AREAS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

| 1 | SECTION 1. The legislature finds that many individuals |
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| ·2 | living in underserved or remote areas of Hawaii need improved |
| 3 | access to medications and pharmacy services. A mobile pharmacy |
| 4 | vehicle that is able to visit these rural areas on a regularly |
| 5 | scheduled basis and provide pharmacy services and dispense low- |
| 6 | cost prescription medications would help to resolve the dual |
| 7 | problem of access to prescription drugs and pharmacists for low- |
| 8 | income populations in isolated areas of the State. The |
| 9 | legislature intends for mobile pharmacy vehicles contemplated by |
| 10 | this Act to complement, not replace, the remote dispensing |
| 11 | pharmacies under section 461-10.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes. |
| 12 | The purpose of this Act is to permit the operation of |
| 13 | mobile pharmacy vehicles by a licensed pharmacy or pharmacist. |
| 14 | SECTION 2. Chapter 461, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is |
| 15 | amended by adding two new sections to be appropriately |
| 16 | designated and to read as follows: |
