A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, part II, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 2 is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "§302A- Sustainability courses; incorporation into
- 5 public high school science curriculum. (a) Beginning with the
- 6 2013-2014 school year, all public high schools shall include
- 7 sustainability courses as part of the science curriculum or
- 8 shall include sustainability issues as part of existing science
- 9 courses. The sustainability instruction shall encompass topics
- 10 such as the development of the State's alternative energy,
- 11 ocean, environmental, recycling, and technological resources or
- 12 capabilities.
- 13 (b) The board, in its discretion, may grant a waiver to
- 14 any individual school subject to the requirements of this
- 15 section. The board shall adopt policies and procedures to grant
- 16 a waiver under this section."
- 17 SECTION 2. The department of education, in collaboration
- 18 with the board of education, shall submit to the legislature no HB LRB 12-0427.doc



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- 1 later than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular
- 2 session of 2013, a report on its progress and efforts to
- 3 implement the requirements of section 1 of this Act, including
- 4 any proposed legislation.
- 5 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
