A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII PUBLIC PROCUREMENT CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 103D-707, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:
3	"§103D-707 Remedies after an award. If after an award it
4	is determined that a solicitation or award of a contract is in
5	violation of law[7]; provided that the violation of law entails
6	an error of at least \$10,000 for contracts less than \$1,000,000
7	or an error of at least ten per cent of the estimated value of
8	the contract for contracts with an estimated value of \$1,000,000
9	or more, then:
10	(1) If the person awarded the contract has not acted
11	fraudulently or in bad faith:
12	(A) The award of the contract may be ratified and
13	affirmed, or modified; provided it is determined
14	that doing so is in the best interests of the
15	State; [or]
16	(B) The contract may be terminated and the person
17	awarded the contract shall be compensated for the
18	actual expenses, other than attorney's fees,

1			reasonably incurred under the contract, plus a
2			reasonable profit, with such expenses and profit
3			calculated not for the entire term of the
4			contract but only to the point of termination; or
5		<u>(C)</u>	If the contract has not been fully executed by
6			all the parties, the award may be rescinded, in
7			which case remedies prior to award shall be
8			applied pursuant to section 103D-706, and the
9			contract may be reevaluated and awarded to the
10			next lowest responsive and responsible bidder or
11			next ranked responsible offeror;
12	(2)	If t	he person awarded the contract has acted
13		frau	dulently or in bad faith:
14		(A)	The contract may be declared null and void; [ex]
15		(B)	The <u>award of</u> contract may be ratified and
16			affirmed, or modified, if the action is in the
17			best interests of the State, without prejudice to
18	·		the State's rights to such damages as may be
19			appropriate[-]; or
20		(C)	If the contract has not been fully executed by
21			all the parties, the award may be rescinded, in
22			which case remedies prior to award shall be

1	applied pursuant to section 103D-706, and the
2	contract may be reevaluated and awarded to the
3	next lowest responsive and responsible bidder or
4	next ranked responsible offeror."
5	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
6	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
7	begun, before its effective date.
8	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
9	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
10	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
