A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SALARIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Act 85, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, section 2, 1 2 as amended by Act 57, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011, section 1, is 3 amended to read as follows: ÷ 4 "SECTION 2. (a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary 5 and notwithstanding the recommendations of the commission on salaries for salary increases, beginning July 1, 2009, and until 6 7 [December 31,] June 30, 2013, the annual salaries of the governor, the lieutenant governor, the justices and judges of 8 9 all state courts, the administrative director of the State or an 10 equivalent position, and the department heads or executive 11 officers and the deputies or assistants to the department heads 12 or executive officers of the departments of: Accounting and general services; 13 (1) 14 (2) Agriculture; 15 (3) The attorney general; 16 (4)Budget and finance; 17 Business, economic development, and tourism; (5) 18 (6) Commerce and consumer affairs;

    effective on the date specified by the commission on salaries in
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    accordance with its recommendations.] the salary recommendations
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of the 2006 commission on salaries for these positions effective

July 1, 2012, shall become effective on July 1, 2013.
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- 3 (b) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary and
- 4 notwithstanding the recommendations of the commission on
- 5 salaries for salary increases, beginning July 1, 2009, and until
- 6 [December 31,] June 30, 2013, the annual salaries of members of
- 7 the legislature shall be reduced by five per cent from what the
- 8 salary is as of June 30, 2009; provided that the salary
- 9 recommendations of the 2006 commission on salaries for
- 10 legislators effective January 1, [2014] 2013, shall become
- 11 effective on [that date in accordance with the recommendations.]
- 12 July 1, 2013.
- (c) For the period from July 1, 2009, to [December 31,]
- 14 June 30, 2013, notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the
- 15 leaves of absence for vacation and sick leave, with pay, of

- 17 as those negotiated, mediated, or arbitrated under chapter 89,

- 8 (e) This section shall not be enforced to the extent that
- 9 it is preempted by federal law."
- 10 SECTION 2. Nothing in this Act shall limit or modify the
- 11 authority of future commissions on salaries to make salary
- 12 recommendations pursuant to article XVI, section 3.5, of the
- 13 Constitution of the State of Hawaii and section 26-56, Hawaii
- 14 Revised Statutes.
- 15 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
