A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to provide for the 2 re-acquisition by the State of certain parcels of land in 3 Kakaako makai. If re-acquired, the legislature intends that the 4 parcels be developed for medical or scientific uses that 5 contribute to the synergy created in the area by the John A. 6 Burns school of medicine and the University of Hawaii cancer 7 center. 8 SECTION 2. (a) The Hawaii community development authority 9 shall engage in efforts to re-acquire the parcels of land commonly known as the "makai gateway park" and the "Honolulu 10 Ford parcel" in Kakaako makai. 11 The Hawaii community development authority may re-12 acquire the makai gateway park and the Honolulu Ford parcel by: 13 Entering into an agreement to exchange the parcels for 14 (1)other parcels owned by the authority, including any
- 15 16 outside of Kakaako, such as the Heeia parcels received 17 from the Kamehameha Schools; or
- 18 (2) Eminent domain or purchase.



- 1 (c) If the re-acquisition of the makai gateway park and
- 2 the Honolulu Ford parcel requires public funds, the Hawaii
- 3 community development authority shall submit a request to the
- 4 legislature for the necessary appropriation.
- 5 SECTION 3. If the Hawaii community development authority
- 6 re-acquires the makai gateway park and the Honolulu Ford parcel,
- 7 the authority, pursuant to chapter 206E, Hawaii Revised
- 8 Statutes, shall develop or cause the development of the parcels
- 9 into medical or scientific uses that contribute to the synergy
- 10 created in Kakaako makai by the John A. Burns school of medicine
- 11 and the University of Hawaii cancer center.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
