(a) All 4 5 state agencies, except the department of transportation, shall be exempt from all requirements of the building codes and land-6 use-permitting processes of the State and its counties for the 7 8 construction of structures on public lands, as defined in 9 section 171-2. (b) At least one year prior to commencing construction, 10 exempted state agencies under subsection (a) shall notify in 11 writing the mayor of the county in which the construction will 12 **13** occur regarding: 14 (1) The resulting effects on water and sewer use; and The resulting effects on traffic and transportation. (2) 15
