A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PRIVATE TRANSFER FEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 169, Session
- 2 Laws of Hawaii 2010, temporarily prohibited the inclusion in a
- 3 deed of a restriction or other covenant running with the land
- 4 that requires a transferee of real property to pay a fee in
- 5 connection with a future transfer of the property. Prior to Act
- 6 169, there was no regulation over the imposition of private
- 7 transfer fees, no limitation on the application of the fees, and
- 8 no accountability or oversight of the recipients of the fees.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to permanently prohibit private
- 10 transfer fees by eliminating the repeal of Act 169.
- 11 SECTION 2. Act 169, Session Laws of Hawaii 2010, is
- 12 amended by amending section 5 to read as follows:
- "SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval [7]
- 14 and shall be repealed on June 30, 2015]."
- 15 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken.

1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
