### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MEDICAID.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the department of 2 human services operates and has oversight of the State's medicaid program, a program that expends a significant amount of 3 public funds annually. Currently, the department of human 4 5 services sets medicaid policy and changes within the program, without the input of the legislature. 6 7 The purpose of this Act is to bring more transparency into 8 the operations of the medicaid program in Hawaii, and to clarify 9 the role of the legislature in setting medicaid program 10 policies. SECTION 2. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 11 12 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 13 and to read as follows: 14 "§346-Medicaid program. (a) The department shall 15 notify the standing committees of the senate and the house of 16 representatives that have primary jurisdiction for medicaid 17 program oversight about any intended change to Hawaii's medicaid
  - program. The notification shall be made no later than sixty
