## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PUBLIC GUARDIAN.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 551A-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 The public guardian shall serve as guardian, limited 4 guardian, testamentary guardian, or temporary guardian of an 5 incapacitated person when so appointed by the family court or by the circuit court under chapter 560. The public guardian may 6 7 file a petition for the public guardian's own appointment. 8 Petitions for public guardianship may also be filed by any 9 person, agency, or facility responsible for the support or care 10 of individuals who: 11 Are not able to understand or adequately participate (1)12 in decisions concerning their care; and **13** Have no relatives or friends willing and able to act 14 as a quardian.
- 15 At the request of a county chief of police, the attorney general
- 16 may also file a petition for public guardianship for individuals
- who meet the requirements of paragraphs (1) and (2)."
- 18 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
