A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATEWIDE TRAFFIC CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 291C-128, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is			
2	amended to read as follows:			
3	"[f] §291C-128[f] Following or passing stationary emergency			
4	vehicle [prohibited]. (a) The driver of any vehicle other than			
5	one on official business shall not follow any emergency vehicle			
6	traveling in response to an emergency closer than five hundred			
7	feet or drive or park such vehicle within five hundred feet of			
8	where the emergency vehicle has stopped in answer to a fire			
9	alarm.			
10	(b) On approaching a stationary emergency vehicle using			
11	visual signals, a driver who is passing the stationary emergency			
12	vehicle, unless otherwise directed by a police officer or person			
13	of authority, shall:			
14	(1) Vacate the lane closest to the stationary emergency			
15	vehicle when driving on a highway with two or more			
16	lanes traveling in the direction of the stationary			
17	emergency vehicle and continue traveling in that lane			
18	until safely clear of the stationary emergency

16			vehicle the driver may reduce the speed of the
