5	(1)	Approve training programs for nurse aides and ensure
6		that the training programs comply with all applicable
7		federal and state requirements;
8	(2)	Approve and arrange for the recertification process
9		for nurse aides who work in medicare or medicaid
10		certified nursing facilities;
11	(3)	Approve and arrange for the recertification process
12		for nurse aides who work in state-licensed or state-
13		certified health care settings; [and]
14	(4)	Require recertification not less than every two years.
15		The number of continuing education hours required for
16		recertification shall not exceed twenty-four hours,
17		except as specified by federal law[-]; and

1	(5)	Require training programs and the recertification
2		process for nurse aides to include a multicultural
3		health awareness and education program. For the
4		purposes of this paragraph, "multicultural health"
5		means the provision of health care services with the
6		knowledge and awareness of the causes and effects of
7		the determinants of health that lead to disparities in
8		health status between different genders and racial and
9		ethnic populations and the practice skills necessary
