BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is							
2	amended by adding a new section to part X to be appropriately							
3	designated and to read as follows:							
4	"§346- Suits by vulnerable adults; financial							
5	exploitation; amount of recovery. (a) Any vulnerable adult who							
6	is injured by an act of financial exploitation or any person							
7	authorized to act on behalf of the vulnerable adult may sue in							
8	family court or any other court of competent jurisdiction for							
9	damages sustained by the vulnerable adult.							
10	(b) If it is proven by a preponderance of the evidence							
11	that a person has engaged in financial exploitation, the family							
12	court or other court of competent jurisdiction shall award							
13	reasonable attorney's fees and costs to the vulnerable adult, in							
14	addition to compensatory damages and all other remedies							
15	otherwise provided by law.							
16	(c) In addition to any award made under subsection (b), if							
17	it is proven by clear and convincing evidence that the financial							

exploitation was done wilfully, wantonly, or maliciously or
