#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The Hawaii interagency council on homelessness,
established pursuant to executive order 11-21, shall:

(1) Conduct a needs assessment to determine the demand

for, current supply of, and funding possibilities for transitional housing for persons who are at risk of becoming homeless; and

(2) Develop an overall, comprehensive strategy to assist the various populations in need of transitional housing, including coordination of public-private partnerships to increase the availability of transitional housing.

SECTION 2. The Hawaii interagency council on homelessness shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2013.

1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
