A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 The legislature finds that the State is losing SECTION 1. thousands of affordable housing units each year. The State must 2 make it a priority to replace the lost affordable housing units, 3 especially affordable rental units. The legislature further finds that once public school facilities are closed, the use of 5 6 the land thereunder for the development of affordable rental 7 housing would be cost effective and beneficial to the public. 8 The purpose of this Act is to convey closed public school facilities to the Hawaii housing finance and development 9 corporation for development of affordable rental housing, unless 10 the department of education uses the facility to accomplish a 11 greater public good. 12 Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 2.
- SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated

 and to read as follows:
- 16 "S302A- Public school closures; transfer. Upon a
- 17 determination and final action by the board to permanently close
- 18 a public school facility, the board shall convey the closed



- 1 public school facility real property to the Hawaii housing
- 2 finance and development corporation for the development of
- 3 affordable rental housing, unless the board uses the real
- 4 property to accomplish, in the board's opinion, a greater public
- 5 good. A conveyance executed pursuant to this section shall be
- 6 in accordance with section 171-64.7."
- 7 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
