A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that when a vacancy
- 2 occurs for the resident member seat on the Hawaii public housing
- 3 authority board of directors, the resident advisory board is
- 4 required to submit a list of five nominees for consideration by
- 5 the governor. However, there may be situations where fewer than
- 6 five individuals are interested in the seat, which results in a
- 7 delay in providing a list to the governor and the resident
- 8 member seat remaining vacant for extended periods.
- 9 The legislature believes it is important for the residents
- 10 to have a voice on the board. Additionally, a vacancy may
- 11 jeopardize federal funds because the United States Department of
- 12 Housing and Urban Development requires the board of directors to
- 13 include a resident member.
- 14 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to make the
- 15 nomination process more flexible by allowing for a minimum of
- 16 three but no more than five individuals on the list of nominees
- 17 for the resident member seat.

1	SECTION 2. Section 356D-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) If a vacancy occurs for the resident member seat on
4	the board, the resident advisory board shall compile a list of
5	no less than three but no more than five individuals for the
6	governor's consideration for appointment to the board; provided
7	that the nominees to the board shall be:
8	(1) Participants who are directly assisted by the
9	authority under the federal public housing or
10	section 8 tenant-based programs and who need not be
11	members of the resident advisory board;
12	(2) At least eighteen years of age; and
13	(3) Authorized members of the assisted household."
14	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
15	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
