A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to address economic 1 development by establishing, as state policy, an intent to 2 complete or facilitate the completion of a list of ten specific 3 projects within the next ten-year period. 4 SECTION 2. Chapter 226, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 5 amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and 6 7 to read as follows: PROJECTS TO BE COMPLETED BY DECEMBER 31, 2023 8 "PART Ten projects to be completed by December 31, 9 2023. It is the policy of the State to complete or facilitate 10 the completion of the following projects by December 31, 2023: 11 (1) Broadband infrastructure that provides coverage for 12 one hundred per cent of the following land areas in 13 the State: land zoned for business, commercial, 14 industrial, hotel, or resort use and land used for 15

higher education instruction or research;
