BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 328J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

8	condominiums and apartment buildings."
9	SECTION 2. Section 328J-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10	amended to read as follows:

12	enclosed places open to the public. Smoking shall be prohibited
13	in all enclosed or partially enclosed areas open to the public,
14	including but not limited to the following places:
