A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMERGENCY SHELTERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 346-375, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+]\$346-375[+] Temporary emergency shelter. (a) In
- 4 addition to any other duties prescribed by law, the department
- 5 shall develop, in consultation with the four counties, a
- 6 procedure for identifying locations that shall be used for
- 7 temporary emergency shelters for homeless individuals and
- 8 families. The department shall actively partner with and
- 9 monitor the efforts of the counties.
- 10 (b) Each county shall be responsible for partnering with
- 11 nonprofit organizations to locate, designate, and maintain the
- 12 areas that shall be used for temporary emergency shelters. The
- 13 designated locations may include private, county, state, and
- 14 federal lands.
- (c) Whenever a county relocates homeless persons and
- 16 families from public property, the county shall provide access
- 17 to an available temporary emergency shelter and notify the

1 homeless person or family where the temporary emergency shelter 2 is available." 3 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much 5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for the 6 operational costs incurred by the counties relating to the 7 execution of section 1 of this Act. The legislature declares 8 that the appropriation contained in this section is made in 9 satisfaction of article VIII, section 5 of the state 10 constitution. 11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 12 human services for the purposes of this Act; provided that the 13 department of human services shall apportion the moneys among 14 the counties as it deems appropriate.

SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
