A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CONVENTION CENTER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 206E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and
3	to read as follows:
4	"PART . CONVENTION CENTER DISTRICT
5	§206E- Convention center district; purpose. The
6	authority shall serve as the local redevelopment authority of
7	the district to develop uses and activities that promote and
8	encourage use of the convention center. In addition to any
9	other of its duties under this chapter, the authority shall:
10	(1) Consult with recorded landowners in the district to
11	implement activities related to and supportive of the
12	convention center;
13	(2) Assist land users to manage their properties and
14	implement activities related to and supportive of the
15	convention center; and
16	(3) Work with federal, state, county, and other agencies
17	to ensure that infrastructural support is provided for

the district.

16	(5)	Land use and redevelopment activities within the
17		district shall be coordinated with and, to the extent
18		possible, complement existing county and state
19		policies, plans, and programs affecting the district;

21	(6)	Public facilities within the district shall be
22		planned, located, and developed to support the

1		redevelopment policies established by this part for
2		the district and rules adopted pursuant thereto.

5	district	revolving fund, into which shall be deposited:

9	(2)	Moneys directed, allocated, or disbursed to the
10		district from government agencies or private
11		individuals or organizations, including grants, gifts,
12		awards, donations, and assessments of landowners for

14	(3)	Moneys appropriated to the fund by the legislature.
15	(b)	Moneys in the fund shall be used only for the purposes
16	of this p	part.
17	(c)	Investment earnings credited to the assets of the fund
18	shall bec	ome part of the fund.

20	in accord	ance with chapter 91 to carry out the purposes of this
21	part."
