
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 103D-302, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3 "(b) An invitation for bids shall be issued, and shall
4 include a purchase description and all contractual terms and
5 conditions applicable to the procurement. If the invitation for
6 bids is for construction, it shall specify that all bids include
7 the name of each person or firm to be engaged by the bidder as a
8 joint contractor or subcontractor in the performance of the
9 contract and the nature and scope of the work to be performed by
10 each. A bidder shall have two additional days, after the
11 closing of bids to provide the name of each person or firm to be
12 engaged by the bidder as a joint contractor or subcontractor in
13 the performance of the contract and the nature and scope of the
14 work to be performed by each; provided that bids shall be opened
15 pursuant to subsection (d) only after the close of the two-day
16 period. Construction bids that do not comply with this
17 requirement may be accepted if acceptance is in the best
18 interest of the State and the value of the work to be performed




