A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EMERGENCY ENVIRONMENTAL WORKFORCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the collapse of 2 national credit, housing, financial, and other markets has 3 culminated in the current national economic crisis, which 4 continues to have consequences on the local economy, including 5 significant losses in local construction, restaurant, and other 6 industries. The legislature further finds that solutions for immediate relief will require unprecedented levels of 7 8 cooperation between state and local government, and between 9 public and private entities, and bold yet productive proposals. 10 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for the **-11** establishment of an emergency environmental workforce for short-12 term employment for individuals who are unemployed or 13 underemployed due to the slow economic recovery. Individuals 14 willing to accept the challenge of an emergency environmental 15 workforce job would assist the State's efforts to: 16 Maintain and strengthen watersheds throughout the

State;

1	(2) Eradicate the miconia plant, feral coffee trees, and		
2	other invasive plants; and		
3	(3) Reduce coqui frog, coffee borer beetle, and fire ant		
4	populations.		
5	The legislature intends for the revenues generated by		
6	general obligation bond authorizations and appropriations from		
7	the general fund made by this Act to be released only after		
8	approximately sixty-five per cent of the total appropriations		
9	from various funds made by this Act have been released. The		
10	legislature further intends for the director of finance to have		
11	the discretion to determine when approximately sixty-five per		
12	cent of the special and other fund appropriations have been made		
13	in a manner that fulfills the purpose of this Act.		
14	SECTION 2. There is established the emergency		
15	environmental workforce to be attached to the research		
16	corporation of the University of Hawaii for administrative		
17	purposes. The emergency environmental workforce shall:		
18	(1) Employ approximately five hundred to seven hundred		
19	fifty individuals who were terminated from their job		
20	as a result of the local economic downturn. The		
21	individuals shall be employed as six-month contract		
22	employees;		

1	(2)	Supplement the State's current services being provided
2		for the eradication of the miconia plant and other
3		invasive plants, and the reduction of coqui frog,
4		coffee borer beetle, and fire ant populations; and
5	(3)	Coordinate its efforts with the efforts of the
6		department of agriculture, the department of land and
7		natural resources, and the invasive species committee
8		of each county.
9	SECT	ION 3. The research corporation of the University of
10	Hawaii sh	all:
11	(1)	Together with the Pacific Cooperative Studies Unit,
12		develop a planning, administration, implementation,
13		and evaluation strategy, including a program duration
14		plan and a budget for contract and administrative
15		expenses for the sum appropriated;
16	(2)	Develop a recruitment and public information plan, in
17		consultation with private employers with workforces
18		that have been, or that may be, affected by layoffs
19		resulting from the economic downturn;
20	(3)	Develop a strategy for the interviewing and selection
21		of emergency environmental workforce program
22		participants, including physical examinations as

1		necessary to qualify applicants prior to final
2		contract offers;
3	(4)	Request that attorneys employed or retained by the
4	,	University of Hawaii prepare, on an expedited basis,
5		the necessary employment contracts to meet the
6		objectives of the emergency environmental workforce
7		program;
8	(5)	Submit review and assessment reports to the governor,
9		the senate president, and the speaker of the house of
10		representatives every sixty days for the duration of
11		the emergency environmental workforce program; and
12	(6)	Undertake all other necessary activities for emergency
13		environmental workforce program development and
14		implementation.
15	SECT	ION 4. There is appropriated out of the special land
16	and devel	opment fund the sum of \$1,400,000 or so much thereof as
17	may be ne	cessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for the establishment
18	of an eme	rgency environmental workforce to be administered by
19	the resea	rch corporation of the University of Hawaii.
20	The	sum appropriated shall be expended by the research
21	corporation	on of the University of Hawaii for the purposes of this

- 1 Act; provided that no moneys shall be expended without the prior
- 2 approval of the Pacific Cooperative Studies Unit.
- 3 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the forest and
- 4 wildlife resources fund within the special land and development
- 5 fund the sum of \$500,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary
- 6 for fiscal year 2012-2013 for the establishment of an emergency
- 7 environmental workforce to be administered by the research
- 8 corporation of the University of Hawaii.
- 9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the research
- 10 corporation of the University of Hawaii for the purposes of this
- 11 Act; provided that no moneys shall be expended without the prior
- 12 approval of the Pacific Cooperative Studies Unit.
- 13 SECTION 6. There is appropriated out of the land
- 14 conservation fund the sum of \$2,250,000 or so much thereof as
- 15 may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for the establishment
- 16 of an emergency environmental workforce to be administered by
- 17 the research corporation of the University of Hawaii.
- 18 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the research
- 19 corporation of the University of Hawaii for the purposes of this
- 20 Act; provided that no moneys shall be expended without the prior
- 21 approval of the Pacific Cooperative Studies Unit.

- 1 SECTION 7. There is appropriated out of the water resource
- 2 management fund the sum of \$300,000 or so much thereof as may be
- 3 necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for the establishment of an
- 4 emergency environmental workforce to be administered by the
- 5 research corporation of the University of Hawaii.
- 6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the research
- 7 corporation of the University of Hawaii for the purposes of this
- 8 Act; provided that no moneys shall be expended without the prior
- 9 approval of the Pacific Cooperative Studies Unit.
- . 10 SECTION 8. There is appropriated out of the natural area
 - 11 reserve fund the sum of \$1,400,000 or so much thereof as may be
 - 12 necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for the establishment of an
 - 13 emergency environmental workforce to be administered by the
 - 14 research corporation of the University of Hawaii.
 - 15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the research
 - 16 corporation of the University of Hawaii for the purposes of this
 - 17 Act; provided that no moneys shall be expended without the prior
 - 18 approval of the Pacific Cooperative Studies Unit.
- 19 SECTION 9. There is appropriated out of the forest
- 20 stewardship fund the sum of \$500,000 or so much thereof as may
- 21 be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for the establishment of

- 1 an emergency environmental workforce to be administered by the
- 2 research corporation of the University of Hawaii.
- 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the research
- 4 corporation of the University of Hawaii for the purposes of this
- 5 Act; provided that no moneys shall be expended without the prior
- 6 approval of the Pacific Cooperative Studies Unit.
- 7 SECTION 10. There is appropriated out of the pest
- 8 inspection, quarantine, and eradication fund the sum of
- 9 \$1,000,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 10 year 2012-2013 for the establishment of an emergency
- 11 environmental workforce to be administered by the research
- 12 corporation of the University of Hawaii.
- 13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the research
- 14 corporation of the University of Hawaii for the purposes of this
- 15 Act; provided that no moneys shall be expended without the prior
- 16 approval of the Pacific Cooperative Studies Unit.
- 17 SECTION 11. There is appropriated out of the general
- 18 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$2,000,000 or so much
- 19 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to carry
- 20 out the purposes of this Act.
- 21 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the research
- 22 corporation of the University of Hawaii; provided that no moneys



- 1 shall be expended without the prior approval of the Pacific
- 2 Cooperative Studies Unit.
- 3 SECTION 12. The director of finance is authorized to issue
- 4 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$2,000,000 or so much
- 5 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
- 6 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2012-2013
- 7 for the emergency environmental workforce to:
- 8 (1) Fence lands and easements in the state conservation
- 9 district to protect watershed lands; and
- 10 (2) Mitigate invasive species.
- 11 The appropriation made for the capital improvement projects
- 12 authorized by this section shall not lapse at the end of the
- 13 fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is made; provided
- 14 that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as of June
- 15 30, 2014, shall lapse as of that date.
- 16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the research
- 17 corporation of the University of Hawaii; provided that no moneys
- 18 shall be expended without the prior approval of the Pacific
- 19 Cooperative Studies Unit.
- 20 SECTION 13. The moneys appropriated from the general fund
- 21 by section 11 of this Act and the revenues derived from the
- 22 general obligation bonds authorized by section 12 of this Act



- 1 shall be released and expended only when approximately sixty-
- 2 five per cent of the moneys appropriated from funds by sections
- 3 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 of this Act have been authorized for
- 4 expenditure by the director of finance. For the purpose of
- 5 determining the monetary amount that approximates sixty-five per
- 6 cent of the moneys appropriated and allotted under sections 4,
- 7 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10, the director of finance may aggregate the
- 8 amounts authorized for expenditure from those funds.

9 SECTION 14. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
