A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to require the
- 2 county clerk of any county with a population of less than one
- 3 hundred sixty thousand to mail an absentee ballot for each
- 4 primary, special primary, special, general, and special general
- 5 election to all registered voters of any island of the county
- 6 that is not the county seat of government.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 15-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 8 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 9 "(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), the <u>respective</u> clerk
- 10 shall mail an absentee ballot for each primary, special primary,
- 11 special, general, and special general election to each
- 12 registered voter who resides in the county of Kalawao[-] or on
- 13 any island of a county with a population of less than one
- 14 hundred sixty thousand, except for the island where the county
- 15 <u>seat of government is located.</u> The chief election officer may
- 16 adopt rules to carry out this subsection."
- 17 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
