A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SKATEBOARDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "S291C- Skateboards; helmets; fine. (a) No person
- 5 under sixteen years of age shall operate a skateboard unless
- 6 that person is wearing a properly fitted and fastened skate
- 7 helmet that has been tested by a nationally recognized agency
- 8 such as the American Society for Testing and Materials, the
- 9 United States Consumer Product Safety Commission, or the Snell
- 10 Memorial Foundation, and is designed to fit the user and protect
- 11 against head trauma.
- 12 (b) A violation of this section shall be punishable by a
- 13 fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$250. The parent or
- 14 legal guardian having control or custody of an unemancipated
- 15 minor who violates this section shall be liable for the amount
- 16 of the fine imposed.

- 1 (c) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the fines
- 2 collected for a violation of this section shall be deposited
- 3 into the general fund."
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 5 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 6 begun before its effective date.
- 7 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
