1	SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

4	" <u>\$291C-</u> <u>Skateboards; helmets; fine.</u> (a) No person
5	shall operate a skateboard unless that person is wearing a

- 6 properly fitted and fastened skate helmet that has been tested
- 7 by a nationally recognized agency such as the American Society
- 8 for Testing and Materials, the United States Consumer Product
- 9 Safety Commission, or the Snell Memorial Foundation, and is
- 10 designed to fit the user and protect against head trauma.
- (b) A violation of this section shall be punishable by a
- 12 fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$250. The parent or
- 13 legal guardian having control or custody of an unemancipated
- 14 minor who violates this section shall be liable for the amount
- of the fine imposed.
- 16 (c) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the fines
- 17 collected for a violation of this section shall be deposited
- 18 into the general fund."
