A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the supplemental
- 2 nutrition assistance program, formerly known as the food stamp
- 3 program, is a federal and state program to help low-income
- 4 families buy the food they need to stay healthy and be
- 5 productive members of society. In 2010, the federal government
- 6 increased funding to the supplemental nutrition assistance
- 7 program and changed the rules to allow more families to qualify.
- 8 Since many families' receipt of unemployment checks caused their
- 9 gross income to exceed the one hundred thirty per cent
- 10 threshold, the federal government increased the gross income
- 11 limit to two hundred per cent.
- 12 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
- 13 department of human services to respond to the United States
- 14 Department of Agriculture's mandate to amend supplemental
- 15 nutrition assistance program income eligibility requirements,
- 16 thereby increasing the number of potential beneficiaries of the
- 17 program.



- 1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for the
- 4 department of human services to increase staff and the
- 5 department's electronic system's capacity to respond to the
- 6 United States Department of Agriculture's mandate to amend the
- 7 supplemental nutrition assistance program eligibility
- 8 requirement from one hundred thirty per cent of the income
- 9 poverty guidelines prescribed by the United States Department of
- 10 Health and Human Services to two hundred per cent of the income
- 11 poverty guidelines.
- 12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 13 human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
