BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 8-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§8-11 Children and Youth Day and Month. The first Sunday
- 4 in October shall be known and designated as "Children and Youth
- 5 Day", and the entire month of October shall be known and
- 6 designated as "Children and Youth Month". Public events
- 7 celebrating Children and Youth Day and the Children and Youth
- 8 Summit may be held on the grounds of the state capitol on the
- 9 first Sunday in October, unless otherwise determined by the
- 10 governor. This day and month are not and shall not be construed
- 11 to be state holidays."
- 12 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
