A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII BOARD OF REGENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 26-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 The University of Hawaii shall be headed by an "(a) 4 executive board to be known as the board of regents. 5 The board shall consist of fifteen members. At least one 6 member shall be a University of Hawaii student at the time of 7 the initial appointment. This member may be reappointed for one 8 additional term even though the member may no longer be a 9 student at the time of reappointment. The governor shall reduce 10 the terms of those initially appointed to each seat on the board 11 of regents to provide, as far as practicable, for the expiration of three terms each year; provided that the term of the student 12 13 member shall not be reduced. 14 At least twelve members, except for the student member, 15 shall represent and reside in the specified geographic areas as 16 follows:
- 17 (1) Two members from the county of Hawaii;
- 18 (2) Two members from the county of Maui;

1	(3) One member from the county of Kauai; and
2	(4) Seven members from the city and county of Honolulu.
3	An at-large member shall have been a resident of the State for
4	not less than one year immediately preceding the member's
5	appointment.
6	The board shall have the power, in accordance with the
7	Hawaii constitution and with law, to formulate policy and to
8	exercise control over the university through its executive
9	officer, the president of the university. The board shall have
10	exclusive jurisdiction over the internal organization and
11	management of the university."

New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
