### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to part XVII to be appropriately		
3	designated and to read as follows:		
4	" <u>§291C-</u> <u>Green hybrid vehicle; zipper lanes.</u> (a)		
5	Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the director of		
6	transportation shall allow the use of green hybrid vehicles,		
7	regardless of the number of occupants, in contraflow lanes that		
8	have been designated as zipper or zip lanes by the department of		
9	transportation.		
10	(b) The director of transportation shall adopt rules in		
11	accordance with chapter 91 necessary to effectuate this		
12	section."		
13	SECTION 2. Section 291C-221, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
14	amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted		
15	and to read as follows:		
16	"Green hybrid vehicle" means a motor vehicle that:		
17	(1) Has been certified by the United States Environmental		
18	Protection Agency as meeting the tier II emission
