14		Molokai and one representative, chosen by the mayor of
15		the city and county of Honolulu, who shall be

13	consent,	and terms of office provisions of section 26-34, Hawaii	
14	Revised Statutes, as those provisions apply to section 138-		
15	2(a)(2), Hawaii Revised Statutes, the governor, at the		
16	governor's discretion, shall remove one member of the enhanced		
17	911 board who is serving pursuant to section 138-2(a)(2), Hawai		
18	Revised Statutes, upon the appointment of the state chief		
19	information officer or the state chief information officer's		
20	designee to the enhanced 911 board.		
21	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed		
22	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
