A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTRIC VEHICLE PARKING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII: 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to clarify 2 requirements pertaining to parking spaces for electric vehicles. 3 SECTION 2. Section 291-71, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows: 4 5 "[+]\$291-71[+] Designation of parking spaces for electric 6 vehicles; charging [units.] system. [All public, private, and 7 government parking facilities that are available for use by the 8 general public and have] (a) Places of public accommodation 9 with at least one hundred parking spaces available for use by 10 the general public shall [designate] have at least one [per cent of] parking [spaces] space designated exclusively for electric 11 12 vehicles [by December 31, 2011, provided that at least one of 13 the parking spaces designated for electric vehicles is located 14 near the building entrance and is and equipped with an electric 15 vehicle charging [unit.] system located anywhere in the parking

structure or lot by July 1, 2012. Spaces shall be designated,

17 clearly marked, and the exclusive designation enforced. [The

18 electric vehicle charging units shall meet recognized standards,

- 1 including SAE J1772 of the Society of Automotive Engineers. 2 Owners of multiple parking [lots] facilities within the State 3 may designate and electrify fewer parking spaces than required 4 in one or more of their owned properties [as long as]; provided 5 that the scheduled requirement is met for the total number of 6 aggregate spaces on all of their owned properties. 7 [When the number of registered electric vehicles in the 8 State reaches five thousand, the spaces designated for electric 9 vehicles shall increase to two per cent of parking spaces. The **10** number of spaces designated for electric vehicles shall continue 11 to increase by one per cent for each additional five thousand 12 electric vehicles registered in the State until the percentage 13 reaches ten per cent of parking spaces.] 14 (b) For the purposes of this section[, "electric vehicle" 15 means an electric vehicle or neighborhood electric vehicle with 16 an electric vehicle license plate.]: 17 "Electric vehicle" means: 18 (1) A neighborhood electric vehicle; or 19 (2) A vehicle, with four or more wheels, that draws 20 propulsion energy from a battery with at least five kilowatt hours of energy storage capacity that can be 21 22 recharged from an external source of electricity.

11	SECTION 3. Section 291-72, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
12	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:	
13	"(a) Beginning January 1, $[\frac{2012}{7}]$ 2013, any person who	
14	parks a non-electric vehicle in a space designated and marked as	
15	reserved for electric vehicles shall receive a warning."	
16	SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed	
17	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.	
18	SECT	ION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
