## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTRIC VEHICLE PARKING.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to clarify 2 requirements pertaining to parking spaces for electric vehicles. 3 SECTION 2. Section 291-71, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 4 amended to read as follows: 5 "[+] §291-71[+] Designation of parking spaces for electric 6 vehicles; charging [units.] system. [All public, private, and 7 government parking facilities that are available for use by the 8 general public and have] (a) Places of public accommodation 9 with at least one hundred parking spaces available for use by 10 the general public shall [designate] have at least one [per cent 11 of] parking [spaces] space exclusively for electric vehicles [by 12 December 31, 2011, provided that at least one of the parking 13 spaces designated for electric vehicles is located near the building entrance and is ] and equipped with an electric vehicle 14 15 charging [unit.] system located anywhere in the parking structure or lot by July 1, 2012. Spaces shall be designated, 16 clearly marked, and the exclusive designation enforced. **17** 18 electric vehicle charging units shall meet recognized standards,



- 1 including SAE J1772 of the Society of Automotive Engineers.]
  2 Owners of multiple parking [lots] facilities within the State
- 3 may designate and electrify fewer parking spaces than required
- 4 in one or more of their owned properties [as long as]; provided
- 5 that the scheduled requirement is met for the total number of
- 6 aggregate spaces on all of their owned properties.
- 7 [When the number of registered electric vehicles in the
- 8 State reaches five thousand, the spaces designated for electric
- 9 vehicles shall increase to two per cent of parking spaces. The
- 10 number of spaces designated for electric vehicles shall continue
- 11 to increase by one per cent for each additional five thousand
- 12 electric vehicles registered in the State until the percentage
- 13 reaches ten per cent of parking spaces.]
- (b) For the purposes of this section[, "electric vehicle"
- 15 means an electric vehicle or neighborhood electric vehicle with
- 16 an electric vehicle license plate.]:
- "Electric vehicle" means:
- 18 (1) A neighborhood electric vehicle as defined in section
- 19 286-2; or
- 20 (2) A vehicle, with four or more wheels, that draws
- 21 propulsion energy from a battery with at least four

1		kilowatt hours of energy storage capacity that can be
2		recharged from an external source of electricity.
3	<u>"Ele</u>	ctric vehicle charging system" means a system that:
4	(1)	Is capable of providing electricity from a non-vehicle
5		source to charge the batteries of one or more electric
6		vehicles;
7	(2)	Meets recognized standards, including standard SAE
8		J1772 of SAE International; and
9	(3)	Is designed and installed in compliance with article
10		625 of the National Electrical Code.
11	<u>"Pla</u>	ce of public accommodation" has the same meaning as
12	that provided in section 489-2."	
13	SECT	ION 3. Section 291-72, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
14	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:	
15	"(a)	Beginning January 1, $[\frac{2012}{7}]$ $\underline{2013}$ , any person who
16	parks a non-electric vehicle in a space designated and marked as	
17	reserved for electric vehicles shall receive a warning."	
18	SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed	
19	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.	
20	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.	

## Report Title:

Electric Vehicles; Parking

## Description:

Clarifies the electric vehicle parking requirement. Allows an electric vehicle parking space with a charging system to be located anywhere in the parking lot or structure. Effective January 1, 2013, imposes a warning on any person who parks an unauthorized vehicle in a space designated for electric vehicles. Effective July 1, 2030. (HB2485 HD3)
