A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO A DISCOUNT AND SAVINGS PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Many of Hawaii's natural resources are unique
2	to this State. However, especially during times of economic
3	downturn, there are limited funds for the preservation and
4	protection of land and other natural resources managed by the
5	State, including trust lands designated to support native
6	Hawaiian communities.
7	The purpose of this Act is to support native Hawaiian
8	communities by establishing a discount and savings program to
9	generate revenue for the management of trust lands by the
10	department of Hawaiian home lands and to educate program
11	participants about Hawaii's natural resources.
12	SECTION 2. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by
13	adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read
14	as follows:
15	"CHAPTER
16	DISCOUNT AND SAVINGS PROGRAM
17	§ -1 Establishment. The chairperson of the Hawaiian

- 1 discount and savings program that provides a program card holder
- 2 with a series of discounts to businesses, vendors, merchants,
- 3 stores, or other commercial entities. Any start-up costs of the
- 4 program shall be paid for by the department of Hawaiian home
- 5 lands.
- 6 § -2 Price. The chairperson of the Hawaiian homes
- 7 commission shall establish a price for the program card
- 8 commensurate with the services and benefits provided to a
- 9 program card holder.
- 10 § -3 Participation. Any business, vendor, merchant,
- 11 store, or other commercial entity registered to do business in
- 12 the State may choose to participate in the discount and savings
- 13 program. Each participating entity shall offer a discount for
- 14 goods or services, to be determined by the individual business,
- 15 vendor, merchant, store, or other commercial entity to program
- 16 card holders.
- 17 § -4 Program card sales and promotion. The discount and
- 18 savings program card may be made available for purchase at
- 19 certain state-owned offices and properties, the site of any
- 20 participating entity, any office of the department of Hawaiian
- 21 home lands, and other sites to be determined by the chairperson
- 22 of the Hawaiian homes commission. The passenger cruise ship and

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- 1 airline industries shall distribute to passengers on their
- 2 passenger vessels and aircraft arriving in Hawaii, prior to
- 3 debarkation, promotional material on the discount and savings
- 4 program.
- 5 § -5 Development and implementation agreements. The
- 6 chairperson of the Hawaiian homes commission may enter into
- 7 cooperative agreements with government and nongovernment
- 8 entities to develop and implement the discount and savings
- 9 program.
- 10 § -6 Deposit of revenues. Revenues collected from the
- 11 sale of the discount and savings program card shall be deposited
- 12 into the Hawaiian home operating fund established by section 213
- 13 of the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act, 1920, as amended.
- 14 § -7 Program administration. A portion of the revenues
- 15 collected from the sale of the discount and savings program card
- 16 shall be used for the administration of the discount and savings
- 17 program, in an amount determined by the chairperson of the
- 18 Hawaiian homes commission."
- 19 SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act, or the
- 20 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held
- 21 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
- 22 applications of the Act, which can be given effect without the

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- 1 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
- 2 of this Act are severable.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
